 chrome fenders are a distinctive feature of the 1952 model. This Super Rivera is equipped with an automatic transmission
 and a 263 cubic inch engine.
- A 1980 Chevrolet El Camino that has been completely restored. This El Camino is a fifth generation, with a light blue
 exterior and beautiful blue interior which is "as close to perfect as you get," says Bill Wiseman, owner of Wiseman Motor
 Company. It also has brand new tires and a totally rebuilt AC system.
- A 1966 Chevrolet Nova 4-door with a 6-cylinder engine and standard transmission. This second-generation Nova has been

completely restored and the interior is like new. The near-flawless blue Nova comes with many accessories, including radio, heater, front and rear bumper guards, and more.
